**Description:** Perennial, grows to 3 ft. This rush is a grasslike plant with tubular stems that are bright green throughout most of the year. Its small, wind-pollinated flowers bloom in summer.

**Culture:** In the wild, it grows in wet meadows, freshwater tidal and non-tidal marshes, ditches and the edges of ponds. In your garden, it prefers wet soils and full sun. Will tolerate drier sites if shady.

**Ecology:** High wildlife value. Host food plant for the caterpillars of some butterfly species. A common plant of NYC wetlands.
