TALL MEADOW RUE

(Thalictrum pubescens)



Description:

Perennial, grows to 9 ft. Upright plant, with delicate, finely divided blue-green leaves. Flowers are white, resembling starbursts. Blooms in summer.

Culture: Grow in moist, rich soils in a damp sunny or lightly shaded spot. In the wild it grows in open wet woods, marshes, and wet edges along streams. It is rare in NYC.

Ecology: Attracts butterflies and bees.
